God Loves You Right Now – No Matter Who You Are

- It can be hard to admit that you've made mistakes, but the truth is, we all have.
- The wrong you've done in your life has separated you from God.
- But even so, God is willing to forgive you.

God Has Provided A Way For You



"For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him" (Romans 5:6–9)

- The great news is that, even though there's nothing you can do to help yourself and reconcile yourself to God, God has already done that for you.
- Jesus came to take the punishment you deserve for all the wrong you've committed and gives you forgiveness and eternal life with God instead.

How Do I Receive God's Forgiveness and Grace?



"If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9)

- Your part is asking God for His forgiveness, turning away from your past wrongs, and receiving Christ as your Lord and Savior.
- If you haven't done so, why not pray to God right now and do this?

You Mean That's It?



"For it is by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works so that no one can boast" (Ephesians 2:8-9)

- When it comes to receiving forgiveness and salvation from God, yes.

Am I Really Safe And Secure With God?

- He cares enough to equip you to enjoy everlasting life with Him.




So Does God Really Care About Me?
